All identity source documents shall be bound to the applicant and shall be neither expired nor cancelled. PIV and PIV-I credentials requiretwo forms of identification, one primary and one secondary. The secondary identity source document may be from the primary or secondary list, but if from the primary list it cannot be of the same type as the primary identity source document.
